## **Eligibility Criteria for Radiotherapy Technologists**

As per the decision taken by AERB regarding the eligibility criteria for those candidates who have passed Radiation Therapy Technologists training programs not in line with recent AERB requirements with respect to course content and/or affiliation are as follows:

The candidates, whose minimum basic qualification is 10+2 Science and having experience of less than 5 years will be regularized through safety certification program, recognized by AERB, within a period of one year. In the meantime such candidates are permitted to work as Radio Therapy Technologists.

Further, following is decided with regard to Institutions running such programmes:

- (i) Radiation Therapy Technologists' program, where basic entry level qualification is 10+2 in Science but the course content is not as per AERB requirements, should align their course curriculum in line with recent AERB requirements before admitting next batch of students, failing to which they should not enroll students for the next batch.
- (ii) Radiation Therapy Technologists' training program whose course content is in line with recent AERB requirements but not affiliated to any Board/University, should get their program affiliated to any recognized Board/University by 2013 failing to which they should not enroll students for the year 2014 onwards.

This has approval of the Competent Authority.
