28TH DAE SAFETY & OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS MEET

The 28th DAE Safety & Occupational Health Professionals Meet will be jointly hosted by Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) & Indian Rare Earths Limited, OSCOM (IREL, OSCOM) at Bhubaneswar. The chosen theme of the Meet is "Emerging Trend in Environment Protection" & "Life Style Diseases" which are felt most appropriate considering its importance to various DAE units. It is expected that the Meet will provide a mutual forum of exchange of information for further improvement in environmental aspects of DAE units and will also help to reduce life style diseases.

On the first day, the Meet will be inaugurated by Chairman AEC followed by an Endowment Lecture by an eminent personality and also invited talks by other experts sharing their rich experience. The Meet will be a forum for information sharing among the Industrial Safety and Occupational Health Professionals of various DAE units. Exhibition stalls displaying latest personal protective equipments and other safety appliances will also be arranged in parallel.

NOMINATION

Keeping in view of the logistics and constrains on accommodation, it is requested that only maximum of three officers from each unit shall be nominated.

The nominations should reach to Chairman, Local Organising Committee on or before 30th September 2011 in the enclosed nomination form.

VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

The Meet will be held at Bhubaneswar, Odisha.

Delegates are requested to give the eligibility rate for hotel accommodation including food in the nomination form. All the delegates should pay the hotel bill directly to the Hotel authorities.

ABOUT IREL

Incorporated in 1952 to process monazite for the recovery of Thorium, Uranium and Rare Earths compounds at Rare Earths Division, Alwaye. 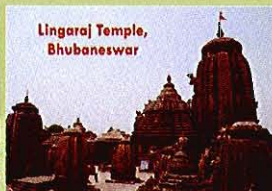
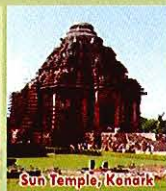


Construction work started at OSCOM for 10,000 tpa capacity Monazite Processing Plant for the production of Uranium, Thorium and Rare Earths compounds.
