

Exhibition and Awareness program on India Nuclear Energy and Radiation in Health Care 2012 (25th-27th September 2012)



Atomic Energy Regulatory Board put up exhibits on the regulatory processes in regulation of nuclear and radiation facilities in the country at Bombay Exhibition Centre, Goregaon, Mumbai from 25-27th September 2012. The exhibit was visited by around 100 visitors. Many appreciated this idea of exhibits for the specific purpose of spreading awareness about regulatory requirements and radiation safety.

The exhibit on AERB Safety Codes, Safety Standards, Safety Guides and Safety Manuals attracted particular attention. The exhibits also aimed at giving a correct perspective on doses vis-à-vis doses received by way of medical diagnostics and natural background and the actual public dose received due to radioactive discharges from Nuclear Power Plants.

The visitors' queries were related to AERB accreditation of various services, future outsourcing possibilities of different regulatory functions such as Regulatory Inspection, and the changes in the regulatory procedures in the near future.
