The programme has the aim that RSO of the facilities, who have attended the programme, will further train / disseminate the information to rest of the logging-engineers / supervisors of respective institutions based on deliberations of the programme. The topics delivered in the programme were “Basics of ionizing radiation and safety”, “Overview of Safety and Security of Well-logging Sources”, “Transport of well-logging sources”, “Typical Checklists, which are to be verified during storage / transport / use of well-logging sources”, “Demonstration of video-clips on use of radiation survey instruments”.

Executive Director, AERB delivered the key-note address, emphasizing the importance of safety and security of sources and creating awareness among all concerned personnel of the institute, who involved in management of the radioactive sources.
