AERB hosted a workshop jointly with USNRC on Aircraft Impact Assessment during February 05-07, 2018 at AERB, Mumbai.

As a part of bilateral arrangement between Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) and United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC), a three days' workshop on Aircraft Impact Assessment (AIA) was held during February 05-07, 2018 at AERB, Mumbai. A three member delegation of USNRC participated in the workshop. The workshop addressed aspects related to aircraft impact assessment for NPPs and regulatory framework associated with it including mitigating strategies for loss of large area of plant on account of beyond design basis external events.

There was a special session on post-Fukushima enhancements which included presentations from experts of AERB and NRC on Post Fukushima safety improvement measures for NPPs carried out in respective countries.

As a part of the workshop, one day visit to the Post-Fukushima safety up-gradation carried out at Tarapur Atomic Power Station 1&2 (TAPS 1&2) was also arranged for NRC delegation.
